They do their fabrication on CRS Mild Steel and convert it into different dimensions through the various processes like CNC CO<sub>2</sub> laser, CNC bending, MIG welding, Shot blasting, Metalizing, Converted paint plant and Converted powder coating etc. Besides fabrication, woodworking operations were also performed with various wood working machines. At last various components are assembled to form a complete roof light window and then packaging of the product is done. All components of roof light windows are exported to the United Kingdom (UK). Students got the opportunity to see all the practical operations performed on various machines for the fabrication of components of roof light windows. Students observed the various operations with keen interest and gave suggestions for improving the productivity and waste minimization. Mr. Praveen Sharma, MD of Crishna International gave an insight of how a business can be started and what are the challenges that come across while you run your own business. He gave a deep insight on idea generation and shared his experiences. This visit was organized for the

students with an objective of providing them functional opportunity in different sectors which also helps to combine theoretical knowledge with industrial knowledge.
