Submission Guidelines

- Prospective authors from India and abroad are invited to submit manuscripts reporting original unpublished research and recent developments in the topics related to the conference.
- Submissions must include title, abstract, author affiliation with email address and keywords.
- Paper should be submitted as per template which is available on conference webpage.
- The paper should not contain page numbers or any special headers or footers.
- Regular papers should present novel perspectives within the general scope of the conference.
- Short papers (Work-in-Progress) are an opportunity to present preliminary or interim results.
- Posters are intended for ongoing research projects, concrete realizations, or industrial applications/projects presentations.
- The paper length should not exceed 8 pages. However, the authors can extend maximum 12 pages over length page charge of Rs.1000 per pages.
- Literature reviews/survey papers will only be considered if they present a new perspective or clearly benefit the field. To be published, such papers must go beyond a review of the literature to define the field in a new way or highlight exciting new technologies or areas of research.
- All submitted papers will be subjected to a "similarity test" by Turnitin Software.
- Papers achieving a 20% similarity score will be examined and those that are deemed unacceptable will be rejected/withdrawn without a formal review.
