## Dear Sir/Madam,

Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), the apex integrity institution of the country, endeavours to promote integrity, transparency and accountability in public life has decided that this year Vigilance Awareness Week would be observed from 31<sup>st</sup> October to 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 with the theme "Corruption free India for a developed Nation; भ्रष्टाचार मुक्त भारत-विकसित भारत".

CVC has advised to conduct activities relevant to the theme, both within and outside their respective organizations and to conduct outreach activities for public /citizens. The CVC Circular in this regard dated 8.9.2022 is available on CVC website <a href="https://www.cvc.gov.in.">www.cvc.gov.in.</a>

The effort shall be made to conduct the activities and outreach programs in a way so as to bring about maximum public participation with an aim to sensitize the public about the need for transparency and integrity in public governance. The suggested activities which may be conducted within the organization and outreach activities for public/citizens are as under:

a. All stakeholders shall publicise Integrity Pledge amongst all employees, their families, vendors/suppliers/contractors/stake holders, students etc. to elicit wider participation, Integrity Pledge for citizens and organizations.

b. All stakeholders may undertake activities such as walkathons, marathons, street plays, etc. which have

visibility and mass appeal across all strata of society.

c. Extensive use of social media platforms, bulk SMS/emails, WhatsApp etc. to spread awareness. For different social media related initiatives, the social media handles of the Central Vigilance Commission may be tagged.

d. Grievance redressal camps for citizens/customers/students be organized.

Further, as per directions of Ministry of Education it is requested that all the AICTE approved institutes and all the organizations under the administrative control of AICTE should conduct activities as advised by the Commission and ensure maximum participation of stakeholders especially students in the outreach activities during the Vigilance Awareness Week-2022. Institutions are also advised to send report to CVO, AICTE along with photographs by November 30, 2022 on email vigilance@aicte-india.org.
