The Government of India has launched the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (<https://cybercrime.gov.in/>) to enable victims or complainants to report cybercrime complaints online. This portal is exclusively designed to address complaints related to cyber crimes, with a particular emphasis on crimes against women and children. Law enforcement agencies and police departments investigate complaints registered on this portal based on the information provided. Therefore, it is crucial to provide precise and accurate details while filing complaints to ensure prompt action.

In case of an emergency or for reporting crimes other than cyber crimes, please get in touch with your local police. The national police helpline number is 112. For reporting crimes against women, the national women helpline number is 181, and for cyber crimes, you can contact the Cyber Crime Helpline at 1930.
