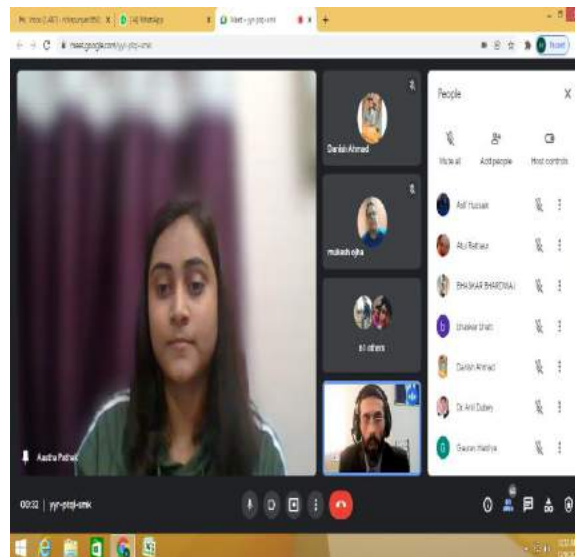
ALUMNI TALK ON OPPORTUNITIES IN DOTNET (9 December 2021, Thursday)

WOMEN AWARENESS CAMP (11 December 2021, Saturday)

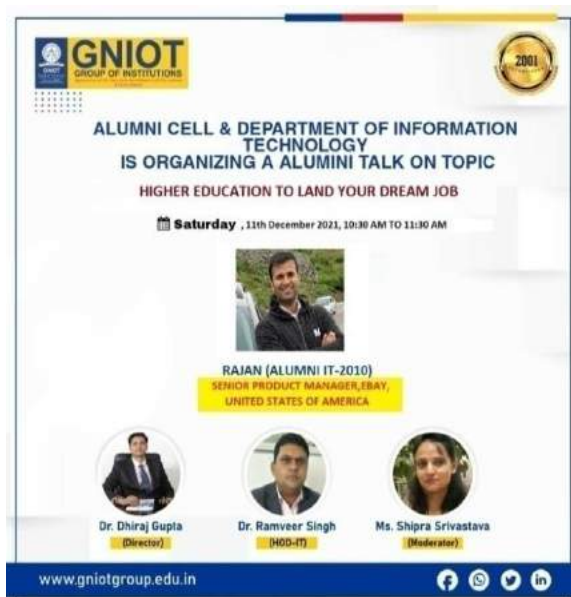
