Newly appointed student President of the club, Deepak Kumar addressed the club



ALUMNI TALK ON OPPORTUNITIES IN DOTNET (9 December 2021, Thursday)



Ms. Astha Pathak is working in Dot net frame work and share her views with faculty members and the students of the Department.




The online was attended by around 75 attendees including the students of II, III & IV year. It turned out to be an interesting session wherein the students actively interacted with the Alumnus along their different queries.

WOMEN AWARENESS CAMP (11 December 2021, Saturday)


