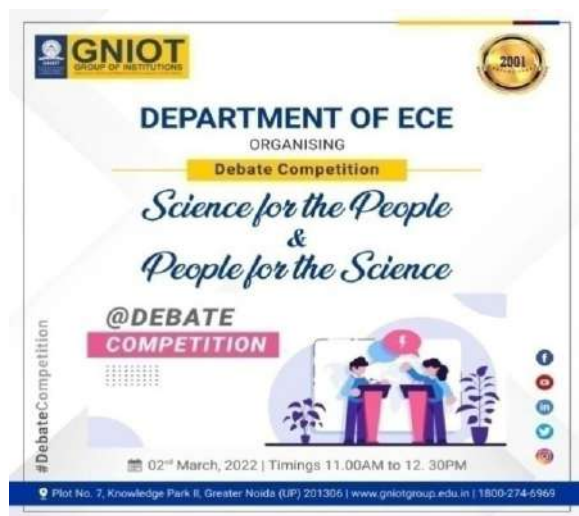

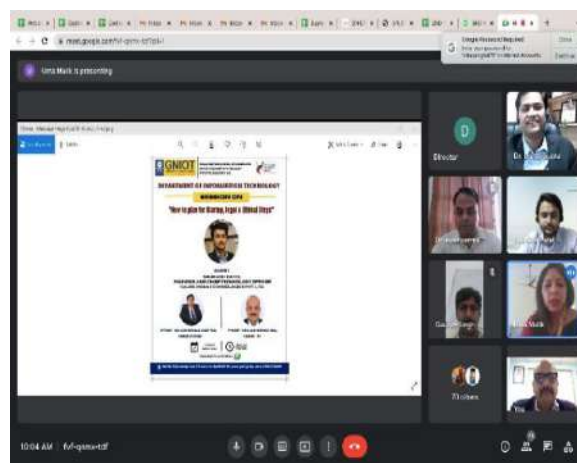

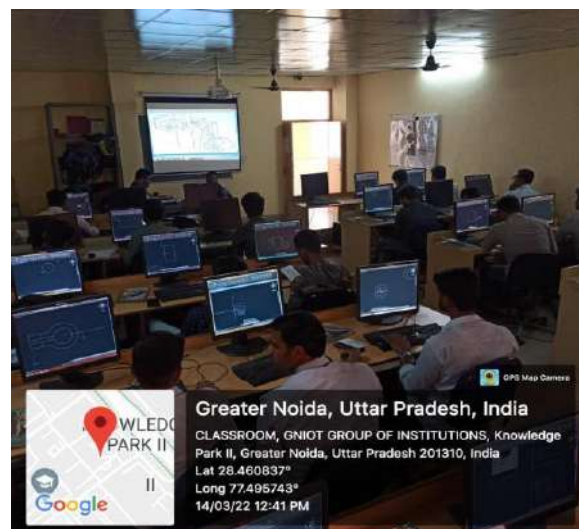
Certification Program of 'AUTO-CAD Competition Monday, 14 March 2022

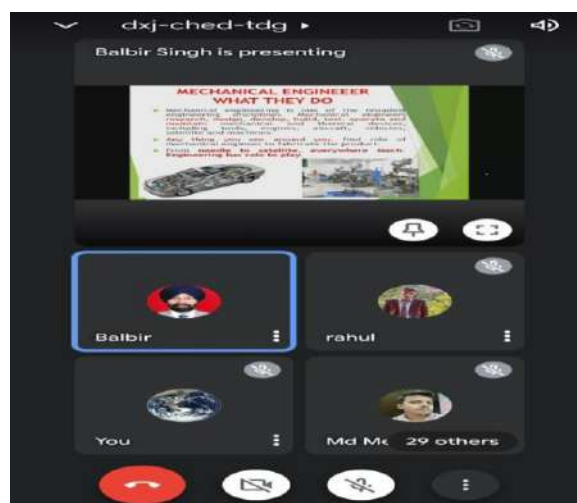
EXPERT LECTURE ON THE TOPIC 'CAREER COUNSELING' (Friday, 25 March 2022)

Department of Mechanical Engineering has organized an expert talk on 'Career Counseling' for the students of Mechanical engineering under the banner of its

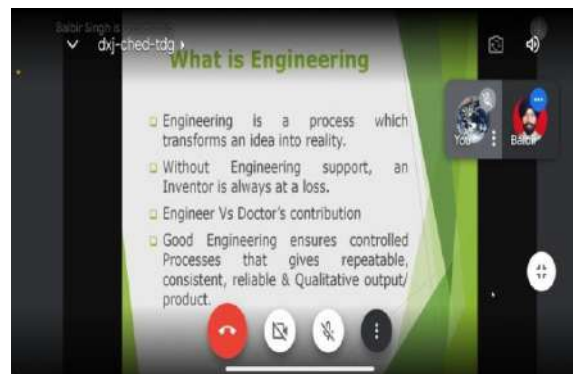
Technical Club and in association with Institutional Technical Committee (ITC).

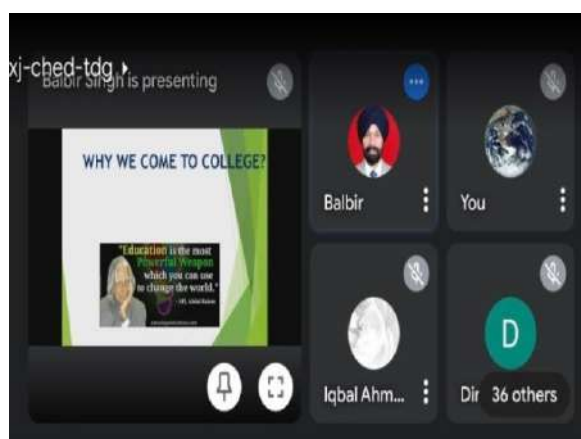
